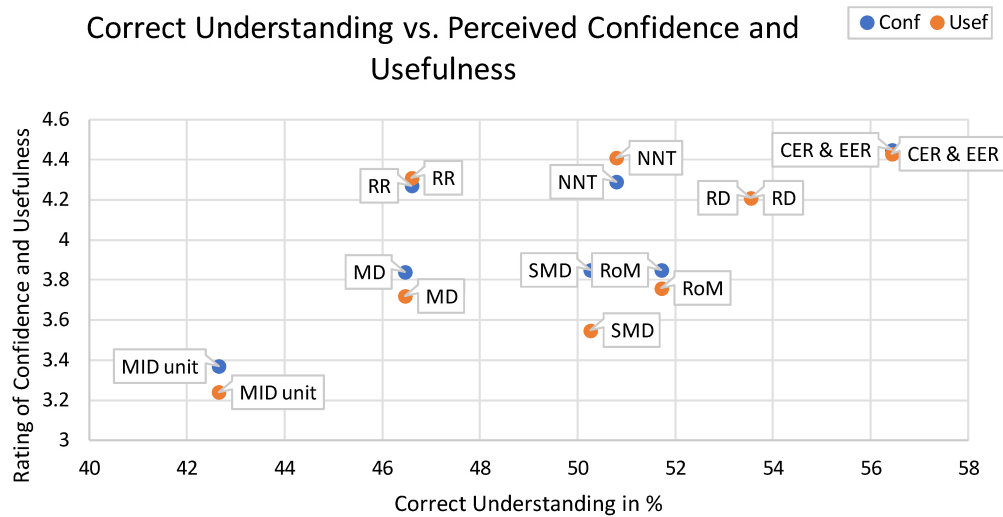

Figure: Perceived confidence and perceived usefulness



Participants' perceived confidence and usefulness (on a scale between 1 and 7) related to the effect size measures and their percentage of correct estimations. A higher value stands for higher confidence/usefulness.

MID unit = difference in minimal importance difference units, MD = mean difference, RR = risk ratio, SMD = standardized mean difference, NNT = number needed to treat, RoM = ratio of means, RD = risk difference, CER & EER = control event rate and experimental event rate.
